


October 11th, 2025

2. ECONOMIC DIPLOMACY



October 12th, 2025

Expand North Star 2025, took place at Dubai Harbour from 12th to 15th October, which is the region's premier platform connecting global start-ups, investors, and innovators. The Pakistan Pavilion at Expand North Star 2025 was inaugurated by Ambassador Faisal Niaz Tirmizi alongside Mr. Rafique Ahmed Buriro, Additional Secretary, Ministry of IT & Telecom/CEO Ignite, H.E. Hussain Muhammad, Consul General of Pakistan in Dubai; Mr. Ali Zeb Khan, Trade Counsellor; Mr. Muhammad Saleh, Press Counsellor; and Mr. Bilal Abbasi, General Manager (Projects), Ignite - National Technology Fund. The Advisor to the Finance Minister, Mr. Khurram Schehzad, was also present on the inauguration. Ambassador Faisal Niaz Tirmizi, highlighted the remarkable growth of Pakistan's IT exports to the UAE, which reached USD 376 million in FY 2024-25. He further noted that Pakistan's global IT exports have surpassed USD 3.76 billion, reflecting the country's growing footprint in international technology markets.






October 14th, 2025




