AMBASSADOR OF PAKISTAN TO THE UAE MEET UAE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND EMIRATIZATION

July 05th, 2025






July 17th, 2025

August 10th, 2025

The 78th anniversary of Pakistan's Independence Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm at the Dubai Exhibition Centre in Expo City. The event was attended by H.E. Sheikh Nahyan bin Mubarak Al Nahyan, UAE Minister of Tolerance and Coexistence, along with Pakistan's Ambassador to the UAE, Faisal Niaz Tirmizi. September 23rd, 2025

CONSUL GENERAL HIGHLIGHTS ONLINE SERVICES, REMITTANCE GROWTH, AND YOUTH HUB

July 28th, 2025

Pakistan's Consul General in Dubai, Hussain Mohammed, urged the Pakistani community to use the official online platform for passport and ID card services, also highlighted features like faster delivery, online appointments, and courier services. He noted a significant rise in remittances from the UAE. The consulate partnered with local banks and exchange houses to promote legal remittance channels. He also called on the Pakistani government to invest more in skill development for overseas workers, mentioning the upcoming launch of a Youth Hub portal to connect skilled individuals with job opportunities abroad.



August 05th, 2025

The Embassy of Pakistan, Abu Dhabi observed Youm-e-Istehsal-Kashmir to mark the 6th anniversary of India's continued illegal actions of 5th August 2019, aimed at altering the internationally recognized disputed status of the Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu & Kashmir (IIOJK).



H.E. Hussain Muhammad, the Consul General of Pakistan in Dubai, highlighted the importance of marking Youm-e-Istehsal as a gesture of solidarity with the oppressed people of Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK). He emphasized that a lasting resolution to the Kashmir issue can only be achieved by honoring the will of the Kashmiri people and adhering to the relevant United Nations Security Council (UNSC) resolutions.



The Consulate General of Pakistan in Dubai, in partnership with New Horizon, successfully hosted the Career Fair 2025 on August 6th and 7th, with the goal of creating job opportunities for Pakistani nationals residing in the UAE. The fair included walk-in interviews to recruit candidates for more than 600 driver vacancies. H.E. 


September 24th, 2025
