Pakistan Welcomes UAE Foreign Minister H.H. Sheikh Abdullah Bin Zayed for Official Visit to Islamabad


April 20th, 2025




June 08th, 2025

June 16th, 2025

PAKISTAN AND UAE SIGN BILATERAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif oversaw the signing of a bilateral cooperation agreement between Pakistan and the United Arab Emirates. Federal Minister Ahsan Iqbal and UAE Deputy Minister Abdulla Nasser Lootah inked the MoU, marking enhanced collaboration between the two nations.









June 24th, 2025

Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Mohammad Ishaq Dar presented the Hilal-e-Quaid-e-Azam to H.E. Mohamed Saif Al Suwaidi, Director General for Abu Dhabi Fund for Development in Abu Dhabi. The Pakistani government bestowed this honor in recognition of Al Suwaidi's significant role in strengthening Pakistan-UAE bilateral cooperation.

June 24th, 2025

The 12th session of Pakistan-UAE Joint Ministerial Commission (JMC) was held in Abu Dhabi on 24 June 2025. It was co-chaired by Deputy Prime Minister/Minister of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, Senator Mohammad Ishaq Dar, and Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the UAE, H. H. Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan. Both sides emphasized enhancing institutional mechanisms and promoting inter-ministerial coordination. Memoranda of Understanding on "Mutual Exemption of Entry Visa Requirements and "Establishment of a Joint Task Force to Promote Investments" as well as an Agreement on "Artificial Intelligence and Digital Economy" were signed







June 24th, 2025

A working group meeting of the JMC was held under the leadership of Special Assistant to the Prime Minister of Pakistan Tariq Bajwa and Minister of State of the United Arab Emirates Ahmed Ali Al Sayegh.







June 25th, 2025

Pakistan and the UAE held their second bilateral political consultations in Abu Dhabi. The Pakistani delegation was headed by Additional Foreign Secretary Shehryar Akbar Khan, while the UAE side was led by Deputy Assistant Minister Reem Ketait. The two sides reviewed entire gamut of bilateral relations, exchanged views on regional and international issues and reaffirmed commitment for continued cooperation.

April 07th, 2025

He also reinforced the UAE's significance as a key trading partner. The inauguration was also attended by H.E. Consul General Hussain Muhammad.

April 21st, 2025

UAE Deputy Prime Minister H. H. Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan held meeting with Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif during his official visit to Islamabad. The two leaders explored ways to enhance bilateral cooperation across trade, energy, investment and cultural exchanges. They also exchanged views on current regional and international developments.

April 30th, 2025

H.E Consul General Hussain Muhammed and Prof. Dr. Chaudhry Abdul Rehman, inaugurated Pakistan Pavilion at GETEX 2025 in Dubai on 30th April. The Pavilion was visited by UAE's Sheikh Nahyan bin Mubarak Al Nahyan, endorsing stronger UAE-Pakistan educational ties. Ambassador Faisal Niaz Tirmizi also attended, commending the delegation's efforts to showcase Pakistan's educational strengths.





May 02nd, 2025
