

June 07, 2024

Ambassador Faisal Niaz Tirmizi received the ICAP team, comprised of President Farrukh Rehman and Secretary Omair Jamal, in Dubai. Productive discussions on enhancing professional ties and collaboration were held during the meeting.



#### Date Palm Festival to be held in Pakistan This Year

Secretary General of Khalifa International Award for Date Palm Agriculture Innovation, Dr. Abdelouahhab Zaid, met with Pakistan's Envoy to the UAE. 26 June, 2024



The launch of KuickPay, an online payment service, was held at the Embassy. The founders, Mr. Saqib Ali Kazmi and Mr. Arbab Ali Khan, introduced the services available through their platform. Ambassador Tirmizi praised such initiatives for supporting the Pakistani community abroad.





### Strengthening Ties Ambassador Tirmizi & Minister Al Awar Discuss Support for Pakistani Diaspora in UAE

Ambassador Faisal Niaz Tirmizi met with HE. Dr. Abdulrahman Abdulmannan Al Awar, Minister of Human Resources and Emiratisation in Dubai. They discussed issues concerning the Pakistani diaspora in UAE, mutual cooperation opportunities, and improving visa processing for Pakistanis seeking employment in UAE. Minister Al Awar offered assistance in streamlining visa services and both sides agreed to work together on health insurance for Pakistani workers. Senior officials from both countries also attended the meeting held on 14 June 2024.

The Mango Festival at Pakistan Association Dubai, organized by the Pakistan Business Council and the Consulate General of Pakistan, was attended by diplomats, dignitaries, and government officials. #### 2nd July 2024

Flydubai touches down in Islamabad and Lahore, The first flights landed at Islamabad International Airport (ISB) and Allama Iqbal International Airport (LHE) with a warm welcome. Flydubai has launched daily services to Islamabad and Lahore to offer more travel options for customers. The airline's network in Pakistan includes various cities. With a fleet of 88 Boeing 737 aircraft, flydubai serves more than 125 destinations in 58 countries. Flights from Dubai International (DXB) to ISB and LHE are now available for booking.









#### 18 July 2024

A group of business leaders and professionals from Sindh called on Ambassador Faisal Niaz Tirmizi on July 18, 2024 to appraise him of what they are doing in the UAE to promote economic activity, friendship and cultural heritage of Pakistan in the United Arab Emirates.

#### 14th August 2024

Pakistan Ambassador to the UAE speaks to Morning Majlis (Puls 95 Radio) on 14 August 2024 about increased connections and ties with Sharjah, particularly the launch of FlyJinnah flights.





#### 17 August 2024

He talked about the current job market situation in the UAE, particularly in Dubai. He also covered Pakistan-UAE bilateral relations and the expected visit of the UAE President to Pakistan. Additionally, he addressed the possibility of a

\$10 billion investment by the UAE in Pakistan, new visa restrictions for Pakistanis and how the Pakistani Embassy is supporting and facilitating Pakistanis in the UAE.



#### August 24, 2024

H.E. Hussain Muhammad, Consul General of Pakistan in Dubai witnessed an MoU signing ceremony between Pakistan Association Dubai (PAD) and Ulearn LLC at PAD, Dubai. The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for cooperation between PAD and Ulearn LLC to promote education within the Pakistani community in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). The parties aim to provide cost-effective online education that reduces educational costs and travel expenses, while ensuring equal access to quality education for all students through modern e-learning methods. The collaboration seeks to enable students to benefit from experienced teachers. The MoU was signed by Mr. Waseem Ullah Khan, CEO U-Learn and Mr. Khalid Imtiaz, Joint Secretary PAD.



#### 25 August 2024

Ambassador Faisal Niaz Tirmizi visited Zulekha Hospital Sharjah at the invitation of Dr. Zulekha Daud, the Founder and Chairperson of Zulekha Healthcare Group, on 25 August 2024. 




#### 3 September, 2024








#### 14 August 2024
