




Message

PRIME MINISTER OF PAKISTAN MEET PRESIDENT OF THE UAE IN QASR AL SHATI, ABU DHABI

On two days visit the Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif was welcomed in Qasr Al Shati Abu Dhabi, by Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE on February 10th, 2025. The meeting provided an opportunity to exchange views on several regional and international issues of mutual interest, with a focus on recent developments in the Middle East.





On the sidelines of the World Governments Summit 2025, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif interacted with leading Pakistani businessmen in Dubai. The Prime Minister pointed out that inflation was at 2. 4 percent in January and the policy rate was at 12 percent. Exports improved and foreign remittances reached three billion dollars, a record high. He emphasized the need to address economic challenges and highlighted key areas like mining, minerals, and Information Technology for growth. He noted the importance of modernizing agriculture and highlighted a program to train 1000 agriculture graduates in China.

Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif delivered a keynote speech at World Governments Summit 2025 held in Dubai highlighting his government's agenda for economic stability and potential key areas for investment through Pakistan's Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC).

February 11th, 2025

Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif met with His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Prime Minister and Vice President of the United Arab Emirates and Ruler of Dubai. The Prime Minister visited Dubai to participate in the World Governments Summit 2025 at the invitation of H. H. Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid. H. H. Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid warmly welcomed Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, reaffirming deep-rooted and longstanding ties between Pakistan and the UAE.





February 11th, 2025

Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif met with the President of Sri Lanka, H.E. Mr. Anura Kumara Dissanayake. The meeting took place on the margins of the World Government Summit in Dubai. This was the first in-person interaction between the two leaders. Recalling the historical linkages between Pakistan and Sri Lanka, the two leaders agreed to build on the existing goodwill between the two countries.

Prime Minister Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif held a bilateral meeting with H.H. Sheikh Ahmad Abdullah Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah, Prime Minster of the State of Kuwait on 11 February 2025, on the sidelines of the World Governments Summit (WGS) 2025 held in Dubai from 11-13 February 2025. Both the leaders reviewed the fraternal relations and expressed satisfaction on the positive momentum of bilateral ties. They reiterated their commitment for further expanding the bilateral cooperation and transforming the existing relations into mutually beneficial strong economic partnership.


March 03rd, 2025






26th March 2025
